






In Pursuit of Excellence

Silence

- We enter a classroom in silence, stand behind chairs, get out equipment and wait for the teacher to ask us to sit down
- We are in silent in a classroom unless answering a question, asking a question, doing group work or paired work or reading out loud
- Independent work is silent work
- We leave the classroom in silence
- Staff will use the behaviour system you do not get a warning but get a 3 the first time you do something you should not; then 2 then be timed out. Staff should say eg 'that's a 3 for talking'. Class time is not a time to argue!
- Time out = same day detention; more than one time out
 = exclusion next day



Allow others to focus, learn and do so quickly.

- Year 7 & 8 use dining room before school and break
- Year 7 & 8 use dining room toilets at lunchtime
- Year 9-11 use benches before school and break
- Year 9-11 use benches at lunchtime and others
- No other toilets will be open
- We are looking at removing urinals in bench male toilets and replacing with additional cubicles

There will be additional staff on duty

No one should leave class without pass/note – you will be sent back

We should not be using the toilet during lessons unless there is a medical condition – it disturbs learning



Respect the toilets – other people have to use them!


In Pursuit of Excellence

APPEARANCE

- Will be checked at line up in the morning
- Anything that can be corrected to be done then –
 after that you can expect a same day detention
 every time you are wearing uniform incorrectly
 for the rest of the day. Staff will check at start of
 every lesson.
- If the issue cannot be corrected then
 - Out of circulation
 - Detention every eve for the rest of week until sorted
 - If not sorted by the end of the week, exclusion for up to a week afterwards
 - If still not sorted, redirected to another school
 - Only heads of year will grant exemption cards. No card, expect detention.
