



Educake provides online homework and revision. It's based on a bank of thousands of specification-mapped questions.

They're automatically marked, which means that students get instant feedback and therefore areas to revise. Teachers use this information to guide planning in class to aid progress.

Educake is used by the English Department for Key Stage 3 and 4 to check knowledge retrieval, application of knowledge and revision for GCSE.

Educake includes lots of question types, not just multiple choice – students can't just guess. Students move from knowledge to conceptual understanding. Answers are explained and put into context, so students know why an answer is correct and why it matters.

Students can use it with any device: PCs, tablets, phones and it works perfectly on mobile without needing an app.

Educake home learning will be issued as an 'assignment' on Arbor. Students should go to www.educake.co.uk to log in.
