Information Technology	You will be following a comprehensive training programme which offers training in a variety of IT skills. It is varied and you could find yourself using the skills learnt in different environments.
Catering and Hospitality	The Catering and Hospitality Apprenticeship will train you to develop a variety of skills in a certain area of the industry. That could be as a Chef, Front of House, Bartender or waiter/waitress.
Glass Occupations	The Glass and Glazing Industry offers a range of interesting careers, from glass manufacturing, the repair and installation of windows, doors and solar panels, to glass decorating and glass warehousing.
