

Calculators in Exams



Calculators must be:

- Of a size suitable for use on the exam desk;
- Either battery or solar powered;
- Free of lids, cases or covers.

You are responsible for:

- The calculator's power supply;
- The calculator's working condition;
- Clearing anything stored in the calculator;
- Removing parts such as cases, lids or covers.



Calculators must not:

- Be designed or adapted to offer any of the following:
 - Language translators;
 - Symbolic algebra manipulation;
 - Communication with other machines or the internet;
- Be borrowed from another candidate during the examination for any reason;
- Have retrievable information stored in them. This includes:
 - Databanks;
 - Dictionaries;
 - Mathematical formulae;
 - Text.

You must not bring any operating instructions or prepared programs into the exam room with your calculator.
